

Job Service: Every 3rd Wednesday, Job Service ND will be in the Community Room to provide assistance to jobseekers. No registration necessary.

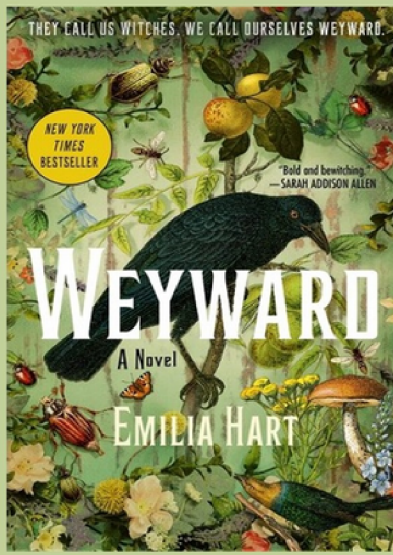
Book Club: Join LRPL staff on the 2nd Thursday of each month at 7:00 pm to discuss the previous month's book pick!
