Book Donation FAQ's

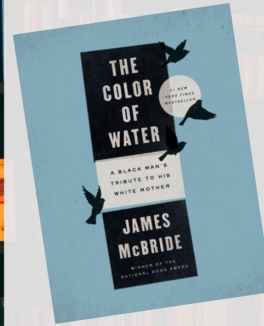
Where should I bring donations? You can bring them to the desk, or if you call in advance we will direct you to the staff door and meet you in the parking lot.

When can I donate books? We accept book donations year-round, **EXCEPT** just before and after book sales. We will announce these pauses, typically about 2 weeks before and 2 weeks after.

What books can I donate? We'll accept gently used fiction almost always. We accept recent nonfiction published within the last ten years, but **we no longer accept textbooks or encyclopedias published more than 10 years ago.**
